2018 was a year of significant growth at Hands Across The Water, both in terms of overall income and expenses, but also in staff size. Going into 2019, our 20<sup>th</sup> year of service to children and families in Southeast Michigan and around the world, Hands Across The Water now employs 40 hard working staff members that served more than 600 individuals and families in 2018.

For the seventh year in a row, HATW was recognized by the Human Rights Campaign's All Children All Families initiative as a leader in serving LGBTQ children and families. This growth and recognition is due, in large, to our incredibly passionate and caring staff who dedicate themselves to our mission and to work that is not often glamorous, but which impacts lives for generations.



# 2018 Year In Numbers



**The number of supportive donors driving HATW's mission has grown 7x since 2016**



**158** youth in the child welfare system received high quality foster care services through Hands Across The Water in 2018

**39** women facing an unplanned pregnancy received free in-home pregnancy counseling

**257** Individuals received in-home parent education services to improve the safety of their home and their skills and capacity as a parent

**52** youth and adults received behavioral health treatment through expanded services to Medicaid recipients

**42** youth in our care found their forever family in 2018

# Special Projects in 2018



Through a partnership with Peace Lutheran Church, Samaritas, Michigan Foster Care Closet, and Judson Center, Hands Across The Water held our first annual Back to School Celebration. Over 100 youth in foster care were served in a single afternoon and received comprehensive 'back to school' resources, including haircuts, clothes, school supplies, a mobile dentist, and more.



Hands Across The Water participated in #GivingTuesday for the first time in 2018. Through our community's generous contributions, we provided over twenty disadvantaged families a gift and grocery card for their holiday meal.



Hands Across The Water celebrated our status as a Leader in Supporting and Serving LGBTQ+ Youth and Families through a successful open house and appeared at the Ypsilanti Pride Festival.




# Statement of Operations - 2018 Fiscal Year
